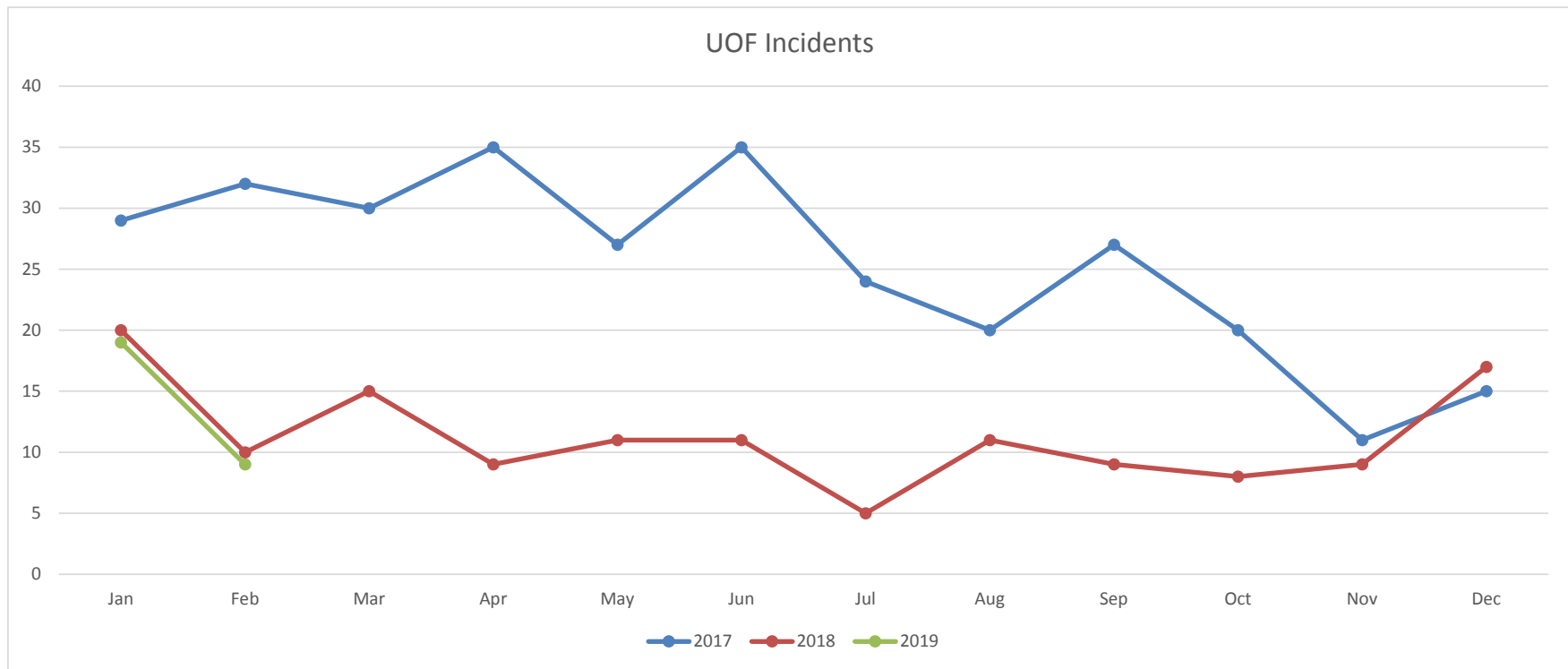

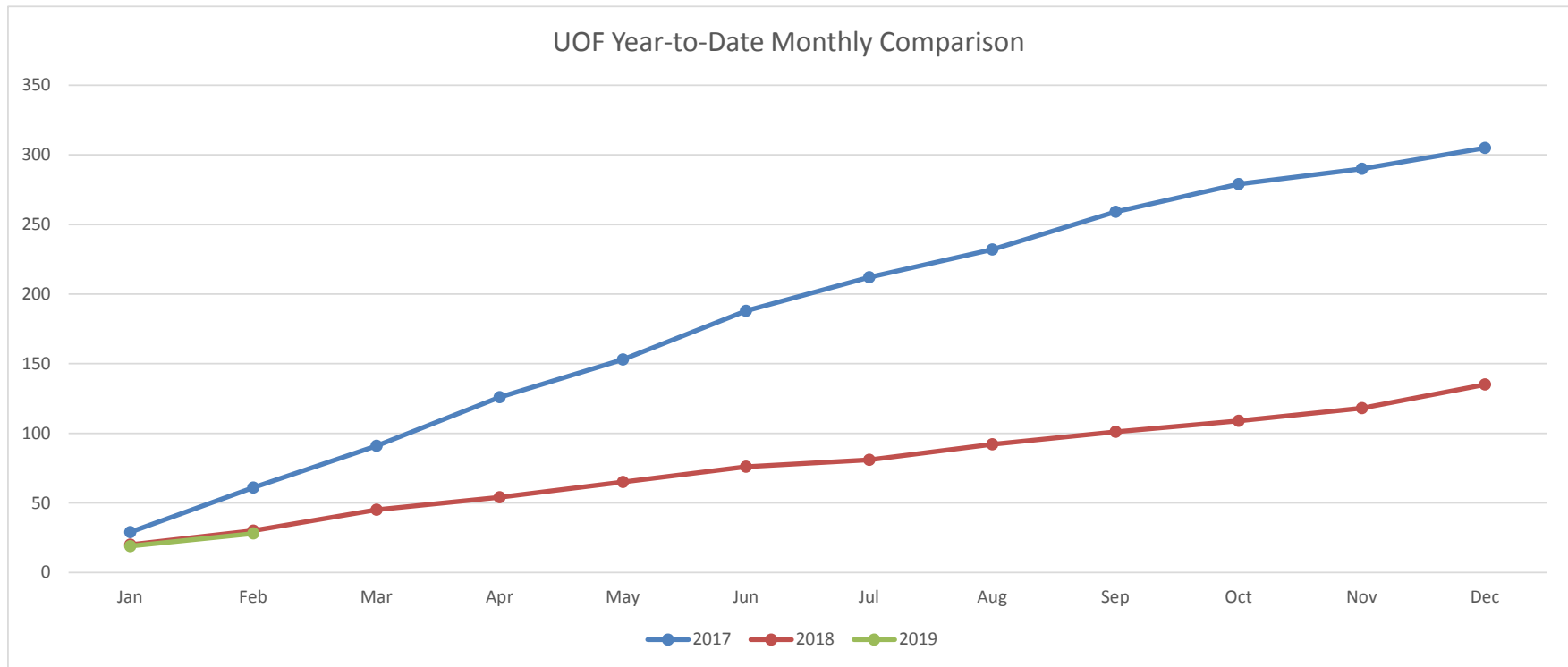

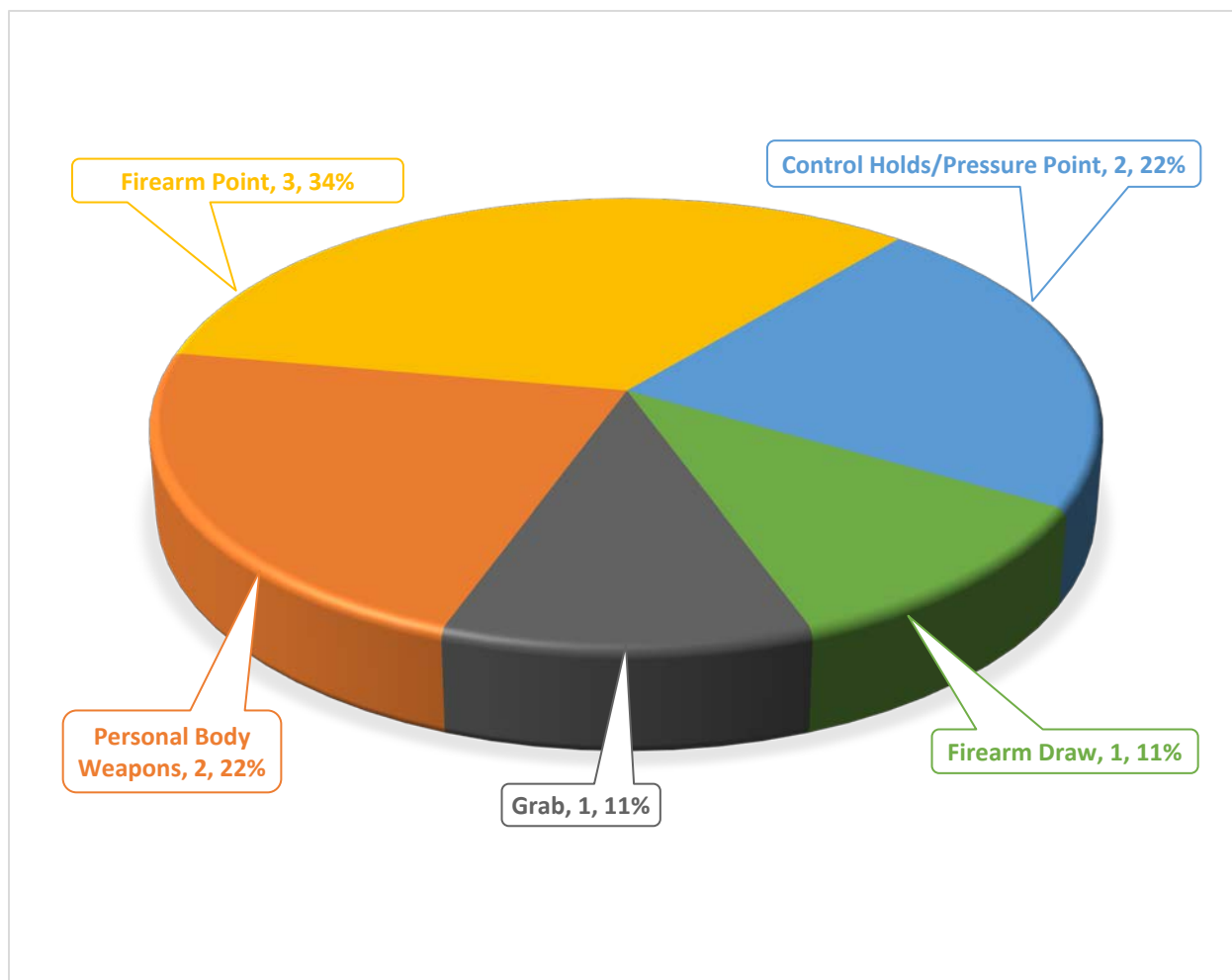

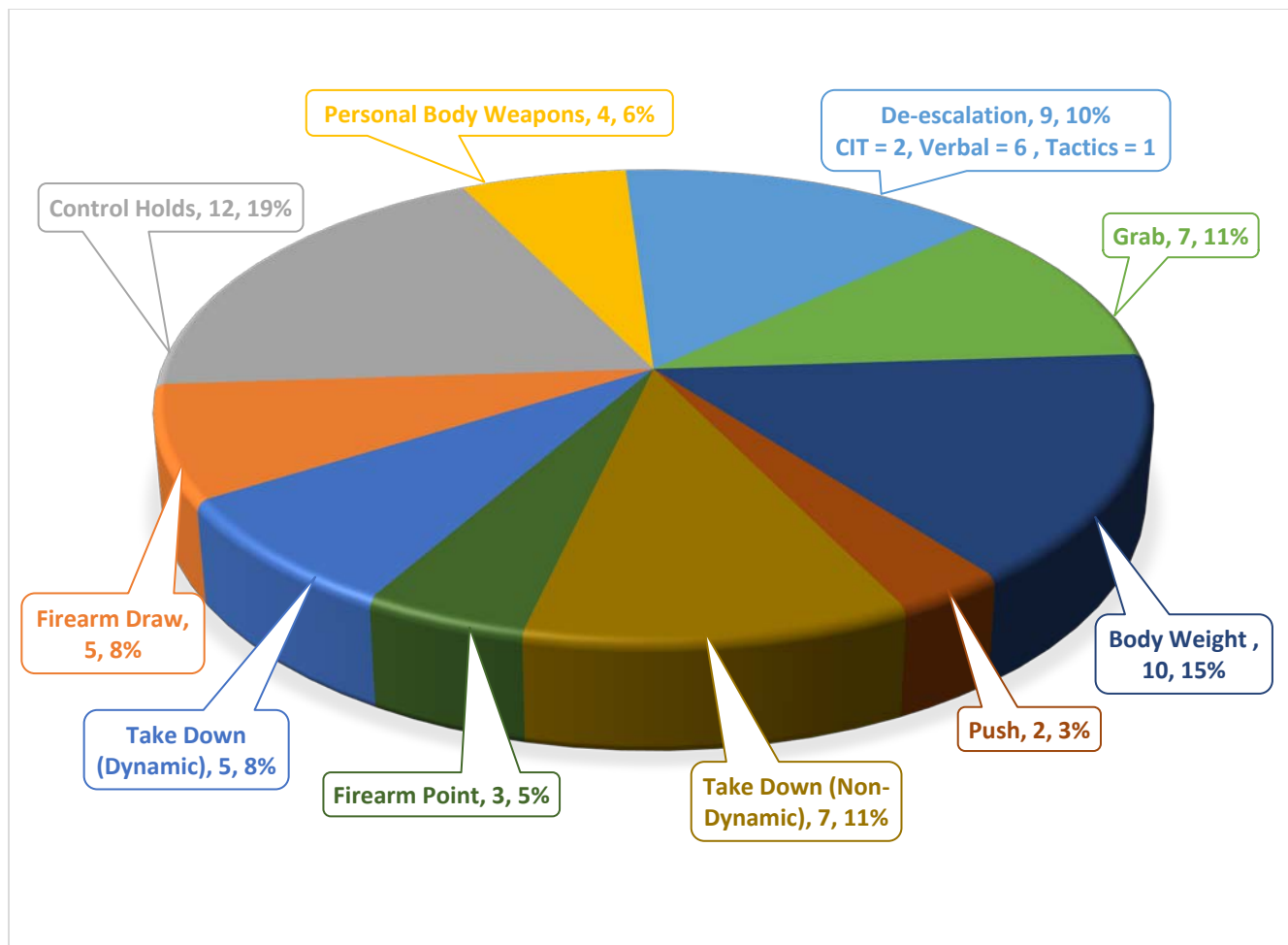


## Force Options Used (Incident Count), February 2019

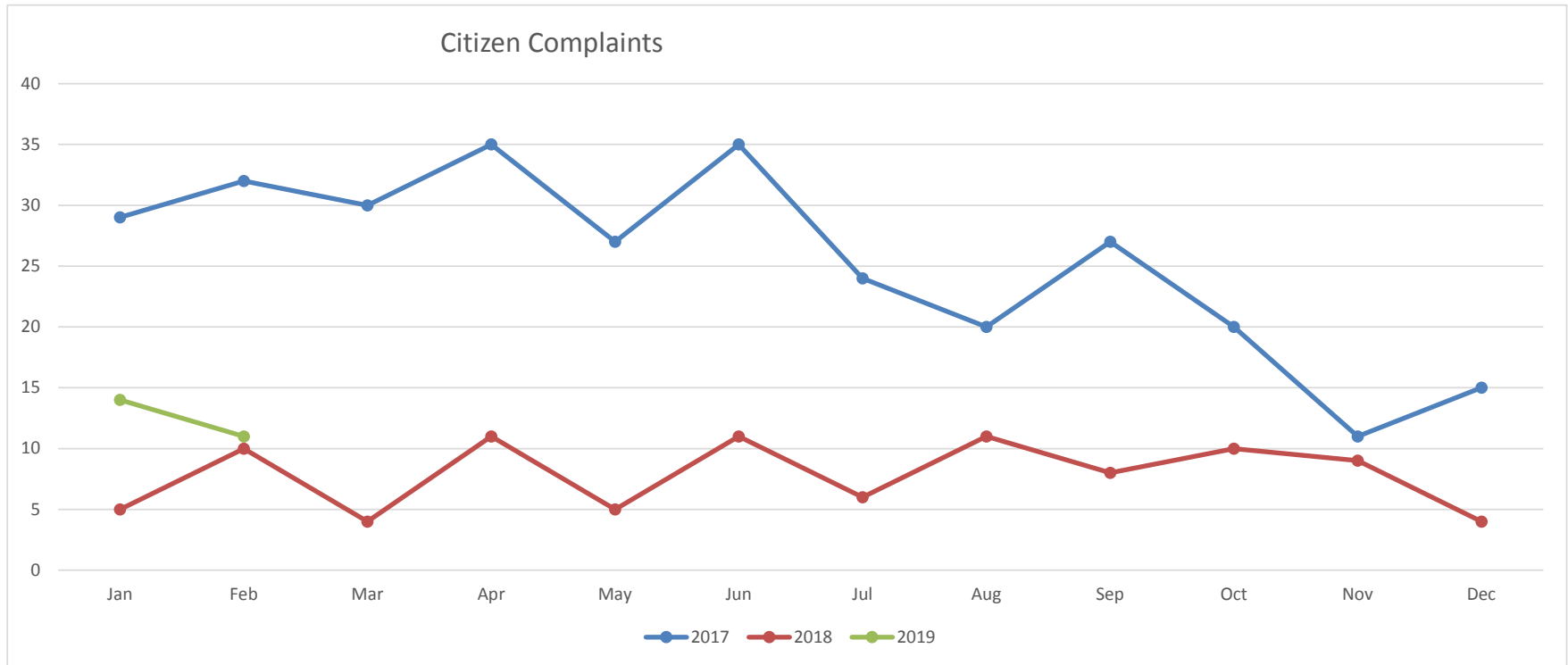

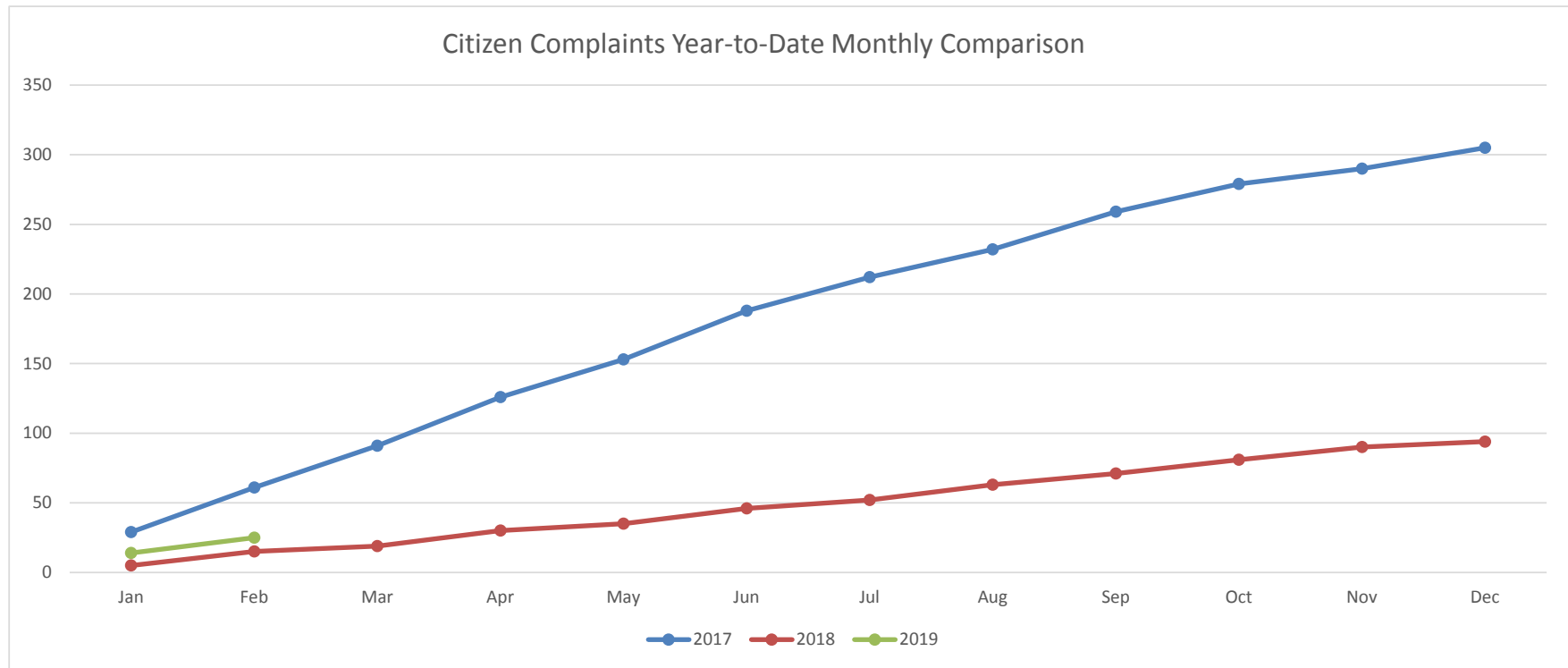

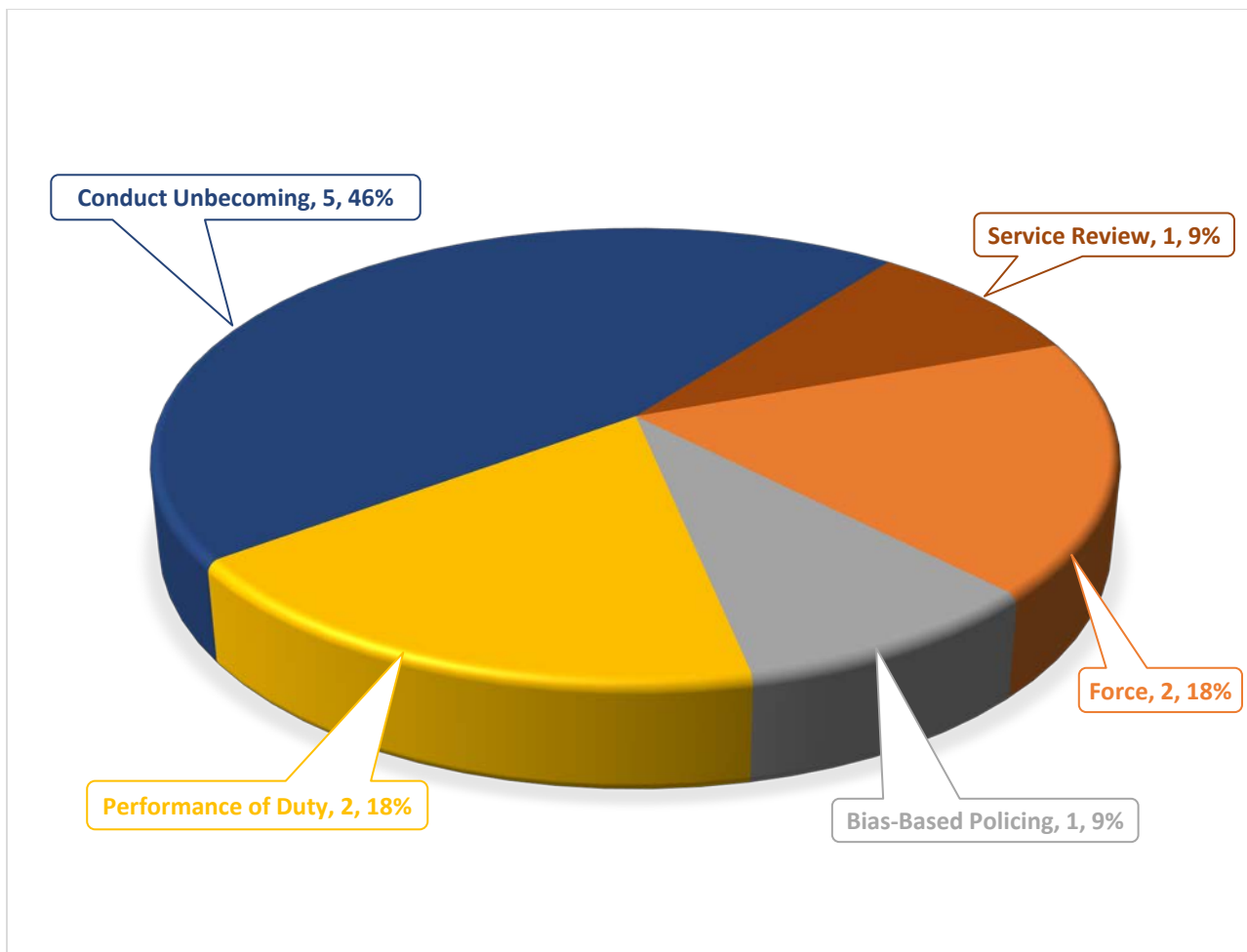

# Complaints Received (Incident Count), February 2019



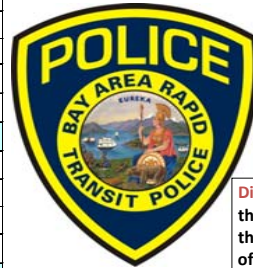
