



We're Rebuilding.

Major rebuilding and Fleet of the Future storage expansion between South Hayward and Union City stations

Project Details

The next focal point for BART's system rebuilding program is southern Alameda County where from May 2021 into the fall of 2022 BART and its contractors will work on replacing some of the oldest track components in the system and begin construction of a new Fleet of the Future storage facility at the Hayward Maintenance. The work between South Hayward and Union City stations is on BART's original service line, which means equipment that dates to the start of service in 1972 will be replaced.

To keep crews safe, BART will close the trackway between the South Hayward and Union City stations on a series of non-consecutive weekends and replace train service with free buses (flip over for map and schedule). Those traveling between South Hayward and Union City should plan to add 20-25 minutes to their trips. Two of the shutdowns will occur on three-day holiday weekends. On May 31st (Memorial Day) and September 6th (Labor Day) free buses will be offered between South Hayward and Union City while the rest of the system will operate on a Saturday train schedule. Crews will work during evening hours when trains are not in service throughout the project's duration. The work will also require BART to reduce service to a single track in the work area on select Saturdays and Sundays, which will cause delays of 15-20 minutes.

Benefits of Work

The benefits of this work will last for decades to come. Riders will enjoy a smoother, safer, more reliable, and quieter ride. Expanding storage capacity at the Hayward Maintenance Complex will facilitate the deployment of more Fleet of the Future cars. Neighbors should notice a decrease in sound from the normal operations of the BART system once the work is complete.

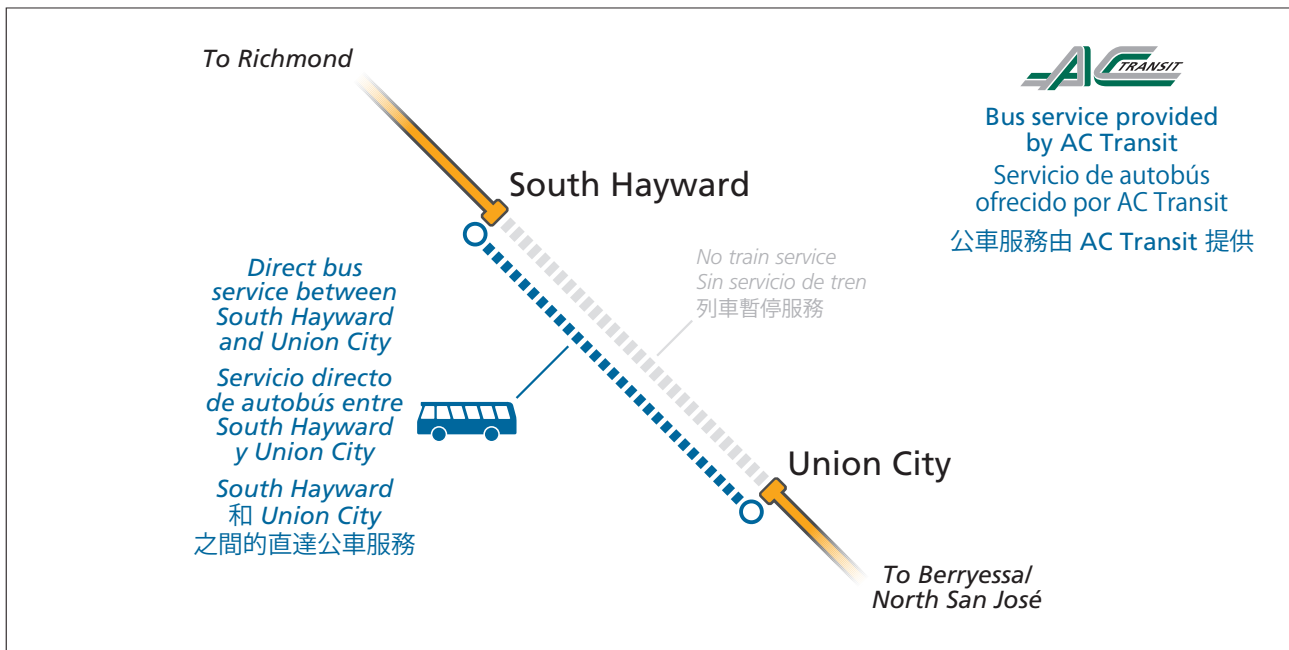
Project Impacts

In order to perform this critical work, BART crews will need to set up lights, generators, excavators, compacting equipment, and other heavy equipment near and on the trackway near South Hayward and Union City stations during the track closure weekends and overnight on some weekdays. Some neighbors and nearby businesses will experience noise coming from equipment and crews along with construction lighting at night. Noise levels are expected to be like those from past maintenance work in the area. Some construction activities will occur during hours when BART trains are not running. Any work that can be completed without disruption to service will be facilitated within these windows.

Additional weekend closures will be required in 2022. This is the initial phase of work at the Hayward Maintenance Complex with additional stages of construction likely to occur over the next several years. Funding

Track rebuilding work is being funded by Measure RR, a \$3.5 billion bond measure that voters overwhelmingly passed in 2016 to rebuild BART to make the system safer and reliable, which in turn helps to reduce traffic. Funding for the new rail car storage facility is provided in part by a \$1.17 billion grant from the Federal Transit Administration.
