#### APPENDIX A-1

#### PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Project Title: 19th Street/Oakland BART Station Modernization Project

#### Project Description:

The San Francisco Bay Area Rapid Transit (BART) 19th Street/Oakland Station, built in September 1972, is forty-seven years old and in dire need of repairs. 19th Street/Oakland Station is located underground along Broadway between 17th Street and 20th Street and serves the north end of Oakland's downtown, an area commonly referred to as the "Uptown" neighborhood.

The 19th Street/Oakland BART Station Modernization Project is aimed at addressing state-of-good-repair issues. Major upgrades will result in improved passenger circulation, increased capacity, enhanced passenger experience, reduced fare evasion, and improvements to wayfinding and safety at the station. The planned station improvements include a new concourse-to-platform elevator for better vertical circulation, new guard rails for safety, taller fare-barrier railing to reduce fare evasion, new LED lighting to replace the fluorescent lighting for better energy efficiency, new bicycle facilities, upgrades to improve the aesthetics of the station, and refurbishment and re-opening of the public restrooms.

#### APPENDIX A-2

### PROJECT SCOPE DETAIL BY PHASE

The ALAMEDA CTC ADMINISTERED FUNDS obligated by this AGREEMENT are to support the project phase(s) identified and described below:

#### CONSTRUCTION

The BART 19th Street/Oakland Station Modernization Project is aimed at addressing state-of-good repair issues; enhancing station lighting and wayfinding; improving passenger circulation; reducing fare evasion; and adding new architectural finishes.

The following improvements will be delivered as part of the BART 19th Street/Oakland Station Modernization Project:

- Reconfigured fare gate arrays with addition of new fares gates to reduce passenger queues
- · Higher fare barriers and expanded "paid area" to prevent fare evasion and improve security
- Increased concourse bike parking
- Upgraded station agent booth
- New north-end elevator providing access between the BART concourse level and both Platforms
- Replacement of fluorescent lighting with new LED lighting fixtures
- Refurbishment and reopening of the public restrooms

- The Allowable Start Date identified for each fund source is the earliest date at which costs eligible for reimbursement by the fund source indicated may be incurred. Any costs incurred on the PROJECT before this date will not be eligible for reimbursement under this AGREEMENT.
- 4. The Expenditure Deadline Date is the last date by which eligible reimbursable costs may be incurred. Any costs incurred on the PROJECT after this date will not be eligible for reimbursement under this AGREEMENT.
- The Agreement Expiration Date shall mean and refer to the expiration date of this AGREEMENT.
- 6. For TFCA funds obligated by this agreement, the Expenditure Deadline Date in the above table is two (2) years from the date when ALAMEDA CTC first received funds from BAAQMD, unless an extended deadline is approved at the time of programming or an extension has been approved by the ALAMEDA CTC. Extended deadlines will be reflected in an amended Table B-1, once approved.
- ALAMEDA CTC may approve up to two one-year extensions to the Expenditure Deadline Date. Any additional extensions
  require approval from both ALAMEDA CTC and BAAQMD.

Pursuant to action taken by the Alameda County Transportation Commission (Alameda CTC) governing body on January 31, 2019, this letter confirms that the San Francisco Bay Area Rapid Transit District (BART) is authorized to apply its Small Business Program to all procurements and contracts funded wholly or in part with Measure B, Measure BB, and/or Vehicle Registration Fee funds administered by Alameda CTC and allocated to BART, in lieu of Alameda CTC's Local Business Contract Equity (LBCE) Program. Notwithstanding the foregoing, BART shall report Local Business Enterprise (LBE), Small-Local Business Enterprise (SLBE), and Very Local Business Enterprise (VSLBE) participation of Alameda CTC certified firms with all invoices submitted for reimbursement for all contracts partially or wholly funded by Alameda CTC, whether or not the contract requires LBE/SLBE/VSLBE participation.

Additionally, as the project sponsor, BART shall comply with the terms and conditions of the Project Funding Agreements with Alameda CTC, including managing all aspects related to procurement and contracting, and indemnify Alameda CTC accordingly. Any inquiries or matters brought to the governing body of Alameda CTC related to BART administered procurements and contracts will be redirected to the BART Board and shall be resolved by BART staff, as appropriate.
