Notification of Construction Hayward Parking Structure

May 2009

Dear BART Patron:

As part of our system-wide Earthquake Safety Program, we will begin strengthening the parking structure at Hayward Station to withstand future earthquakes. **The work will require temporary closure of parking spaces and the total number of parking spaces will be reduced to make space for the work.** During the project, you can expect construction-related noise, dust and inconvenience. Please watch for signs with safety information and other notices. We appreciate your patience and cooperation during this work.

Construction Work Details

- **Description:** Installation of concrete infill walls, adding steel and concrete to foundations and walls, jackhammering, saw-cutting, protecting utilities and equipment
- **Location:** Various locations on the four levels of the parking structure; stairs; and sidewalks
- **Start Date:** May 2009
- **Duration:** Approximately 1 year
- **Hours:** Most work will take place Monday through Friday between the hours of 8:00 AM and 6:00 PM. A limited amount of weekend and night work may be required.
- **Emergency work as necessary**

Related projects to strengthen columns and fixtures at the Hayward station and the adjacent BART aerial structures will occur in the future. Earthquake Safety Program construction will be underway at various locations throughout the BART system over the next five years, and is expected to be complete by the end of 2013. As always, safety is BART's top priority. Our aim is to strengthen BART as quickly as possible, while maintaining BART service.
